STATEMENT OF SERVICE PERFORMANCE

Outcomes.

- To have good quality drinking water available to all members' properties.
- Maintain supply capacity to meet peak demand.
- To upgrade the treatment facilities to fully comply with Taumata Arowai (TA) requirements and our Water Safety Plan.
- To comply with Waikato Regional Council consent conditions for water take and comply with our Water Safety Plan.

Outputs.

- Monthly monitoring of water quality by regular testing through an IANZ-accredited laboratory. All results met quality standards.
- Maximum length of interruption to the supply to members was less than 12 hours.
- Progress on upgrades to water treatment to meet latest TA requirements. Chlorination system and filters established and working well.
- Fully complied with Waikato Regional Councils consent conditions and our Water Safety Plan.

ENTITY INFORMATION

Purpose.

To ensure that a supply of fresh drinking water shall be available at the properties of all our members.

Structure.

A Committee of officers elected annually at the Annual General Meeting operates within accepted Committee guidelines and financial disciplines.

All Committee members act in a voluntary capacity to monitor the supply, comply with relevant legislation and report regularly to members.

The Association employs a Water Operator as required under our Water Safety Plan.

Funding.

The main source of funds comes from Members' levies and capital contributions determined annually at the AGM or Special meetings.

Ability to continue to operate.

The Association is in a strong cash position and members levies are set to cover expenditures each year and build up a Reserve Fund.

STATEMENT OF ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Basis of Preparation

The Grange Road Water Association (Hahei) Inc has elected that all transactions in the Performance Report are reported using the accrual basis of accounting. The performance Report is prepared under the assumption that the Association will continue to operate in the foreseeable future.

Goods and Services Tax (GST)

The Association is not registered for GST. Therefore, the amounts recorded in the Performance Report are inclusive of GST

Income Tax

The Association is wholly exempt from New Zealand income tax having fully complied with all statutory obligations for these exemptions.

Bank Accounts and Cash

Bank Accounts in the Statement of Cash Flows comprise cash balances and bank balances (including short term deposits) with original maturity dates of 90 days or less.

Specific Accounting Policies

- a) Measurement Base The measurement and reporting of results and financial position using the historical cost method has been adopted in the preparation of this Performance Report.
- b) Receivables Accounts receivables are stated at their expected net realisable values
- c) Liabilities Liabilities are stated at the estimated amounts payable and include liabilities which can be reliably estimated. Current liabilities include amounts payable in the next financial period
- d) Fixed Assets and Depreciation Fixed assets are recorded at Residual Value as at 31st
 December 2004 plus subsequent acquisitions at actual cost, less subsequent disposals and less accumulated depreciation. Depreciation has been written off using the Straight-Line basis at rates shown in the Schedule of Assets and Depreciation
- e) Accrual Basis Accrual accounting principles have been applied so as to match income with expenditure in the same accounting periods.

Changes in Accounting Policies

There have been no changes in accounting policies during the financial year (last year nil).

FINANCIAL REVIEW REPORT

To the Members of the Grange Road Water Association (Hahei) Incorporated

I have examined the Performance Report of the Grange Road Water Association (Hahei) Inc. which includes information about the financial position of that society as at 31st December 2022 and its financial performance for the year ending on that date. This information is stated in accordance with the accounting policies set out in the Statement of Accounting Policies.

Committee's Responsibilities

The Committee is responsible for the preparation of financial statements which fairly reflect the financial position of the Society as at 31st December 2022, and its financial performance for the year ended 31st December 2022.

Reviewer's Responsibilities

It is my responsibility to express an independent opinion on those financial statements prepared by the Committee and report my opinion to you.

Basis of Opinion

A review includes examining on a test basis evidence relevant to the amounts and disclosures in the financial statements. It includes assessing the significant estimates and judgements made by the Committee in the preparation of the financial statement and whether the accounting policies are appropriate to the Society's circumstances, consistently applied and adequately disclosed.

I conducted my review in accordance with generally accepted review standards in New Zealand. I obtained all the information and explanations which I considered necessary in order to provide myself with sufficient evidence to give reasonable assurance that the financial report is free from material misstatements whether caused by fraud or error. In forming my opinion, I also evaluated the overall adequacy of the presentation of the information in the financial statements.

Other than my capacity as the Financial Reviewer of the financial statements for 2022, I have no other interest in the Grange Road Water Association (Hahei) Inc.

Opinion

Nothing has come to my attention which would cause me to believe that the financial statements do not fairly reflect the financial position of the Society as at 31st December 2022 and of its financial performance for the year ended on that date.

My review was completed on 14 March 2023 and my opinion is expressed as at that date.

My instructions from the Committee did not include an audit and I therefore did not conduct an audit.
